# Valentinstag

Talking about liking someone - mostly using the verb mögen - to like (irregular)

- ♥ Ich mag dich. – I like you.
- ♥ Ich hab dich gern. – I like you.
- ♥ Magst du mich? – Do you like me?
- ♥ Magst du mich nicht? – Don't you like me?
- ♥ Ich mag ihn. – I like him.
- ♥ Ich mag sie. – I like her.
- ♥ Er mag mich. – He likes me.
- ♥ Sie mag mich. – She likes me.
- ♥ Er mag sie. – He likes her.
- ♥ Sie mag ihn. – She likes him.
- ♥ Er mag sie nicht. – He doesn't like her.
- ♥ Sie mag ihn nicht. – She doesn't like him.

**Alles Liebe zum Valentinstag**

Saying that you love someone - mostly using the verb lieben - to love (regular)

Love may be a complicated emotion, but at least the verb for "to love" in German is totally regular. Yay!

| CONJUGATION OF lieben – to love |                     |                   |
|---------------------------------|---------------------|-------------------|
| Infinitive: lieben              | Singular            | Plural            |
| 1 <sup>st</sup> person          | ich <b>liebe</b>    | wir <b>lieben</b> |
| 2 <sup>nd</sup> person          | du <b>liebst</b>    | ihr <b>liebt</b>  |
| 3 <sup>rd</sup> person          | er/sie <b>liebt</b> | sie <b>lieben</b> |

Texting a love message...

- ♥♥ Ich liebe dich. – I love you. (romantic)
- ♥♥ Ich hab dich lieb. – I love you. – usually to other people you love, e.g. your parents, children, siblings and friends
- ♥♥ Ich hab dich sehr lieb. – I really love you.
- ♥♥ Ich hab dich wirklich total lieb. – I really love you.
- ♥♥ Ich bin in dich verliebt. – I'm in love with you.

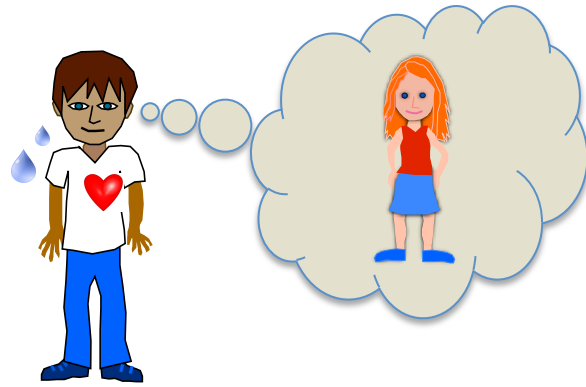

## Saying that you miss someone

- 💧 Ich vermisse dich. – I miss you.
- 💧 Du fehlst mir. – I miss you.
- 💧 Ich habe Sehnsucht nach dir. – I long for you.



### Vocabulary

- die Sehnsucht – longing
- fehlen – to be missing, lacking
- vermissen – to miss (a person, not a class or a train!) – e.g. Ich habe dich sehr vermisst!

## Giving someone a compliment

- Du bist nett/süß/schön. – You are nice/sweet/beautiful.  
 Du siehst gut/schön/schick aus. – You look good/beautiful/classy.  
 Du bist mein bester Freund. (to a boy) – You're my best friend.  
 Du bist meine beste Freundin. (to a girl) – You're my best friend.  
 Das ist ganz lieb von dir. – That's very kind of you.  
 Du bist ein guter Freund. (to a boy) – You are a good friend.  
 Du bist eine gute Freundin. (to a girl) – You're a good friend.  
 Danke für das Kompliment! – Thanks for the compliment!



## Asking someone out

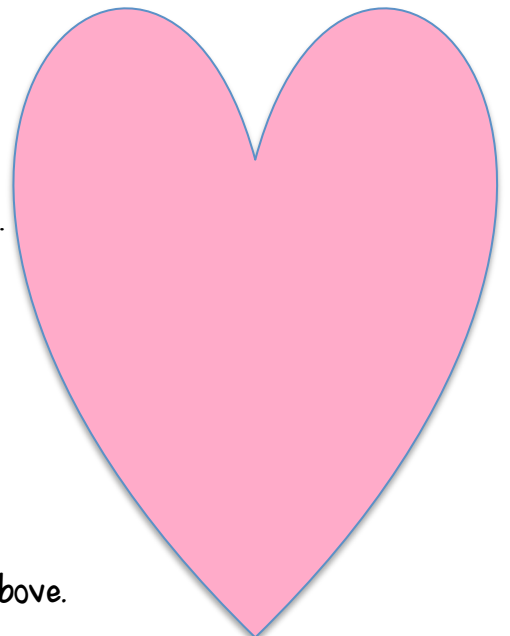
- Möchtest du mit mir ins Kino gehen? – Would you like to go to the movies with me?  
 Hast du heute Abend frei? – Are you free this evening?  
 Kann ich dich wieder sehen? – Can I see you again?  
 Kannst du mir deine Handynummer geben? – Can you give me your mobile number?
